Things to Bring / Not to Bring

What you CAN bring to dorm:

- Alarm clock (*without a radio* - clock must have battery backup)
- Bedding
 - Boys dorm - *Extra long twin mattresses - regular twin size sheets will NOT fit*
 - Girls dorm - *Regular twin size sheets will fit*
- Towels & Washcloth
- Toiletries
- Cleaning supplies
- Clothes hangers
- Laundry detergent and basket (*quarters NOT needed*)
- Wastebasket
- Lamp (*required in girls' dorm*)
- Refrigerator (*optional - see handbook for fee*)
- Personal listening device (*Ipod, CD player, etc, - headphones must always be used*)
- Sabbath church clothes including church SHOES (*See handbook*)
- Work & recreation clothes
- School uniforms
- School supplies

You are welcome to decorate your room, however, all decor and posters must be approved by the dean and be in accordance with Christian principles. Please be prepared to use poster putty and NOT tacks or tape on walls.

All rooms are carpeted and are equipped with two beds, desks, chairs, window blinds, dressers, and closets.

What you CANNOT bring to the dorm:

- BB guns, paint guns, firecrackers or fireworks, weapons of any kind, etc.
- Computers of any kind (with the exception of Seniors)
- Movies and/or movie players of any kind, TV, radio, video/computer games
- Unacceptable music, pictures and reading material
- Halogen bulb lamps or clothing irons
- Hot plates, microwaves, toasters or other electrical cooking devices
- Matches, lighters, candles, incenses and other flammable objects
- Pets
- Drum sets
