



### Early Application Incentive

New students who submit a completed application by Academy Days Weekend receive a discount (\$200 boarding student/\$100 village student).

### New Student Early Registration Deposit Discount

New students who submit a completed application form and make a non-refundable \$100 deposit by June 30 will receive a \$100 match to be applied to registration.

### Grade Point Average Scholarship–Year to Year

Scholarships are awarded to any student whose GPA from their previous school year falls into the categories below. This scholarship will be divided and credited on a monthly basis.

### Family Discounts

Village Students - A monthly 10% tuition discount will be applied to the second and additional student accounts (same family).

Dorm Students - A monthly 15% tuition discount will be applied to the second and additional student accounts (same family).

\*\*Information regarding multi-student discounts for Adventist Church employees is available in the office.

### Summer Camp & Magabook Matching Scholarships

MPA will match 50% of summer camp and literature evangelism/Magabook gross earnings, up to a limit of \$1,000 (or \$2,000 earnings cap).

### Annual Payment Discounts

MPA will give a 4% discount if the total yearly tuition (or tuition and boarding costs) is paid by registration. An estimated amount of student work earnings and other scholarships/credit for the year is subtracted before the discount. Payment must be made by/with cash, check, or electronic withdrawal.

***For all non-academic merit (Academy Days, Leadership, Nosoca Camper, and Jeremiah 29:11) scholarships, students may redeem up to \$1,500 for village students and \$2,000 for dorm students. These scholarships will be spread over the anticipated years of attendance.***

### Academy Days Scholarships

Students attending Academy Days are encouraged to try out for organizational and departmental scholarships (such as music, gymnastics and academic tests). Scholarships up to \$500 may be awarded to some students based on their audition or testing. For academic testing, students who score at the 90th percentile or above will receive scholarships.

### Leadership Scholarship

Students who have shown qualities of leadership and/or have been recommended for their leadership abilities may receive a scholarship. A limited number of students are chosen for this scholarship. Students may also qualify if they held one of the following student positions the year prior to enrolling at MPA.

# NORTH CAROLINA ASSISTANCE OPTIONS

## Opportunity Scholarship Program

The Opportunity Scholarship Program provides tuition assistance of up to \$6,492 per year for awarded students who transfer from a public school to a non public school. Mount Pisgah Academy is a participating non public school that accepts this assistance. The program is income-based.

We encourage eligible, prospective new students to apply for this scholarship. If acquired, this scholarship will nearly cut in half the tuition cost for a student. Registration for the Opportunity Scholarship is opened on February 1, 2023. The Priority Window closes March 1, 2023. The application will remain open until August 31, 2023 for students to be considered, as funds remain available.

## Education Savings Account (ESA)

The Education Savings Account (ESA) Program provides assistance of up to \$9,000 per year for awarded students who enroll in a non public school. This program is for students with **disabilities**. The new student application opened February 1, 2023 and priority deadline is March 1, 2023.

Note: Children who are placed in a non public school by their parents do not have a right to receive all of the special education and related services that they would receive if enrolled in the public schools. Likewise, a private school does not have a legal obligation to provide special education and related services to students with disabilities. Parents are encouraged to select a non public school carefully and to establish a plan prior to enrollment which meets their child's educational needs.

Mount Pisgah Academy does their best to accommodate certain disabilities, but is not equip to assist all students with disabilities. Families are encouraged to speak with our registrar, Shane Bedwell, about what MPA can provide.
